- implement assessment and evaluation practices which:

 - promote growth and improvement.
- establish and enforce Administrative Procedures to maintain safe and effective environments for all students and staff;
- establish a dispute resolution process to be followed if there is disagreement about the appropriateness of the educational programming being provided to a student;
- take appropriate action with staff, students, and/or volunteers who demonstrate behaviours, actions, or attitudes that threaten the academic progress and/or well-being of students; and
- inform the Board before implementing a new program if it is potentially controversial.
