Governance Model

The Board of Trustees commits to the following governance model:

• In the context of Board Governance Policies, the primary role of the Board is the development, implementation, annual review, and approval of Board Governance Policies.

- The Board will focus its energy on effective governance, rather than on daily activities and operations of the Division.
- The Board will develop and monitor Board Governance Policies based on information provided by the Interlake School Division community, advice from educational experts, and provincial requirements.
- The Board will delegate all managerial and administrative authority to the
 Superintendent/CEO, excluding those exemptions defined in Board Governance Policy.
- The Board will annually approve a divisional operating budget consistent with the Board's priorities and the Division's Continuous Improvement Plan.
- The Board will continue to learn and improve through a program of professional development, evaluation, and assessment.
- The Board will annually conduct a performance evaluation of the Superintendent/CEO, giving due regard to Board governance policy.
- The Board will regularly engage in self-evaluation.
