Dear Interlake School Division Families,

On Wednesday, December 2, Manitoba Education shared provincial direction for student programming upon our return from the winter break in January, 2021. To support families and schools in planning, ISD’s response to the provincial announcement is included in this letter.

• **Kindergarten-Grade 6:**

- In-class learning will resume for Kindergarten to Grade 6 students on Monday, January 4.
- Should parents/guardians of Kindergarten to Grade 6 students wish to keep their child at home for the period of January 4-15, remote learning will be provided. Students participating in remote learning will return to in-class learning on Monday, January 18.
- All ISD Teachers have plans in place for remote learning and will distribute these ten-day plans to families who choose remote learning for the period of January 4-15.
- Parents/Guardians who choose to have their child participate in remote learning from January 4-15 are asked to notify their child’s school directly by **Monday, December 14**.

• **Grades 7-12:**

- Students in Grades 7-12 will move to provincially mandated remote learning for a two-week period from January 4-15. Students will learn from home.
- In-class learning will be available for the period of January 4-15 for Grade 7-12 students with special needs that must be accommodated in the school.
- Parents/Guardians of students with special needs will be contacted individually by their child’s school by **Monday, December 14**.
