
The provincial government's recent release of <u>Better Education Starts Today</u> proposes significant changes for Kindergarten to Grade 12 education in Manitoba including the dissolution of the Interlake School Division. The potential impact on students, staff, and communities is an immediate focus of province-wide conversation. The proposed changes shared with Manitobans last week by Education Minister Cliff Cullen are the elected government's response to the recommendations of the <u>Commission on Kindergarten to Grade 12 Education</u> completed in 2019. Manitobans are invited to tell elected officials at the local and provincial levels what they think prior to legislation being finalized and passed.
