Dear Stony Mountain School Families,

The public health situation continues to evolve rapidly for the Stony Mountain School community. We remain in constant contact with public health officials and the purpose of this letter is to provide an update on programming at Stony Mountain School.

All programming for the Grade 5-6 cohort at Stony Mountain School will shift to remote learning for the period of November 1-5.

The temporary shift to remote learning for the Grade 5-6 cohort is being made out of an abundance of caution and is linked to multiple positive cases of COVID-19 within the cohort. The positive cases have also resulted in a significant number of individuals being identified as close contacts and required to self-isolate. We will consult with Manitoba Education and public health regarding programming for the week of November 8-12 and beyond.

Should the need for remote learning for the Grade 5-6 cohort continue beyond Friday, November 5, parents or guardians who are Critical Service Workers (CSWs) that have a need for their child(ren) to attend in-person will be provided the option to do so beginning Monday, November 8. If you are a CSW and have questions about your child’s eligibility to attend, please contact the school directly.

If you have a child in the Grade 5-6 cohort, you can expect to hear from their teacher(s) as soon as they are able to reach out. We will continue to work closely with public health and will communicate with families as soon as possible to provide a programming update for the Grade 5-6 cohort for the week of November 8-12. Thank you for your support.
