Dear ERWBB Families,

Late this afternoon (Wednesday, November 24) a member of the community shared with us their knowledge of a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the Grade 3-4 French Immersion cohort at ERWBB. The individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 was last in the school on Tuesday, November 23, when the individual may have been infectious.

Please note that the school is not permitted to release the name or any identifying information about the confirmed case of COVID-19 to any member of the school, community or media.

It is important for families to know that public health is responsible for:

- Investigating the details of a confirmed case of COVID-19;
- Identifying those deemed to be close contacts of a confirmed case of COVID-19;
- Contacting those identified as close contacts of a confirmed case of COVID-19 and providing instructions for self-isolation.

In conversation with public health officials this evening, we have learned that their investigation of this case will not be completed until tomorrow (Thursday, November 25). Upon completion of their investigation, public health will provide additional information to all ERWBB families.

**Out of an abundance of caution, the students in Mme Paton’s Grade 3 class are asked to remain at home and to not attend school in-person on Thursday, November 25.**

In order to ensure that all families with children in Mme Paton’s class have received this letter and are aware that their child is not to attend ERWBB in-person tomorrow (Thursday, November 25), please reply to sender on this email. If you do not have a child in Mme Paton’s class, no action is required.

Thank you for your support. Further information will be shared with families tomorrow.
