Dear Stony Mountain School Families,

Thank you for being patient, supportive, and understanding as programming for the Grade 5/6 cohort at Stony Mountain School shifted to remote learning for the period of November 1-5 in response to public health concerns related to COVID-19. We respect that this period of time has been difficult for many families and that the health and wellness of community members of all ages has been the priority. Today’s letter intends to provide an update on student programming at Stony Mountain School.

In-person learning for the Grade 5/6 cohort at Stony Mountain School will resume on Monday, November 8. Please note, all students directed to self-isolate by public health as a result of being named a close contact to a positive case or having tested positive themselves may only return to in-class learning upon the completion of their self-isolation period.

All school-related public health investigations of individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 and were at the school during their infectious period have been completed. And, close contacts of individuals who have tested positive either remain in self-isolation or will soon be completing their self-isolation period as directed by public health. We acknowledge that the health of the Stony Mountain School community will continue to evolve and should further change to programming be required, ISD staff will work closely with public health and will communicate with families.

With the return to in-class learning requiring the full attention of Stony Mountain School staff, continuation of remote learning for those families who would prefer to do so will not be possible. As has been the case all year throughout ISD, families with a child who requires medically-advised remote learning who wish to enrol their child in the provincial remote learning program should express this need directly to their Principal.

Thank you for your support. We continue to work closely with public health and invite you to contact Stony Mountain School directly to discuss the needs of your family.
