Dear ISD Families,

Thank you for your support in a great start to the 2021-2022 school year. We sincerely appreciate the patience and understanding of students and families as the ISD Team works to ensure safe spaces for teaching and learning in our schools. The purpose of this letter is to share information regarding a new public health order in effect as of December 6, 2021 which will impact students age 12-17.

As of December 6, 2021, in order for students age 12-17 years to participate in indoor extracurricular sporting activities in Manitoba, the following must be produced:

- Proof that they have received one dose of the Pfizer/BioNTech or Moderna vaccine for COVID-19, or;
- Proof of a negative rapid COVID-19 test result within the previous 72 hours that is confirmed by a pharmacist.

Each school in ISD is different based on the communities and the age of students they serve. For more specific information about how the new public health order will be carried out at your child’s school, please contact the school directly.
