Learning Environment, Programs, and Services

In support of stated belief, vision, mission, and continuous improvement statements, the Board expects equitable, effective, engaging, and caring learning communities.

The Superintendent/CEO will:

- ensure that programs and services comply with federal and provincial requirements;
- promote a culture of mutual respect;
- implement assessment and evaluation practices which:
 - o ensure the achievement of provincial, division, and school goals;
 - o foster an accessible, equitable, and responsive school system; and
 - o promote growth and improvement.
- establish and enforce Administrative Procedures to maintain safe and effective environments for all students and staff;
- establish and maintain a dispute resolution process to be followed if there is disagreement about the appropriateness of the educational programming being provided to a student;
- take appropriate action with staff, students, and/or volunteers who demonstrate behaviours, actions, or attitudes that threaten the academic progress and/or well-being of students; and
- inform the Board before implementing a new program if it is potentially controversial.
