



Continuous Improvement Plan Update

Stakeholder Survey:

ISD recently surveyed stakeholders for feedback on the 2018-2023 Continuous Improvement Plan.

- **260** survey responses were received in total from:
 - Parents/Caregivers: 43% of respondents
 - ISD Staff: 37% of respondents
 - Students: 17% of respondents
 - Community Members: 3% of respondents



What we heard...

Participants were asked to respond to two questions:

What are we doing well? What could we improve?

Responses covered a broad range of school-based and divisional topics and aligned as four key themes to support ISD's planning for continuous improvement:

Sustained Focus, Programming, Expectations for Success, and Communication.

More specifically, survey respondents spoke about the importance of...

- Ensuring full implementation of the work currently underway in schools through a ***sustained focus*** on literacy, numeracy, and well-being.
- Understanding and supporting ***programming*** for the complex and changing needs of students, families, and communities.
- Defining and supporting clear ***expectations for success*** for students and for staff.
- Frequent and purposeful ***communication*** within classrooms and schools and among schools, families, and communities.



Next Steps...

As the ISD Team moves forward with planning for continuous improvement in 2023-2024 and beyond, our next steps include:

- ***April/May:*** Sharing survey data with staff and communities.
- ***May/June:*** Drafting ISD's Continuous Improvement Plan for 2023-2027 based on all available data sources.
- ***September:*** Sharing ISD's finalized Continuous Improvement Plan for 2023-2027.
